




K'sirs' HIGHLIGHTS

We provide daycare facility for students after their school hours on all working days.

We are affiliated to the Council for Indian School Certificate Examinations (CISCE) and the University of Cambridge International Examinations (CIE). It is an International Centre offering the checkpoint, IGCSE and AS/A level Examinations.



CALENDAR

The academic year is divided into 2 terms from June to April.



TRANSPORT

Transport (Pickup and Drop off) facility is available and is provided on a 'first come, first serve' basis. The transportation fee is fixed based on the distance and has to be paid annually.

HOUSES

Students are segregated into four houses: Pegasus, Aquila, Cepheus and Eridanus (PACE), which are names from Greek Mythology. The students participate in all sports and cultural activities representing their respective houses.



LANGUAGE POLICY

- English is the first language and the medium of instruction.
- Tamil is the compulsory Second Language for both ICSE and Cambridge.
- Hindi is offered as the third language in ICSE Curriculum from Grade 4 – 8.
- French and German are offered as the third language in Cambridge Curriculum from Grade 4 – 8.



FOOD AND NUTRITION POLICY

- Lunch should be sent with the child as per the prescribed menu.
- At K'sirs, it is our endeavour to discourage students from having unhealthy food by making them aware of its harmful effects on their health. To reinforce this, we provide simple, light and healthy snacks.
- At school canteen we also provide healthy lunch for students at a cost.

STUDENT'S PROGRESS

To ensure a steady development in our students, we conduct Progression Tests and Cumulative Assessments. Progression Tests are carried out regularly throughout the year, both formally and informally. These assessments serve to identify and analyze the learning lapses. Corrective measures are then implemented as per the requirement of the child.

Progression Tests includes continuous monitoring of student's progress using a variety of methods like:

- 1. Oral Assessments
- 2. Written Assignments
- 3. Projects
- 4. Group Discussions
- 5. Quizzes etc.


Cumulative Assessments are carried out at the end of the course of learning.


