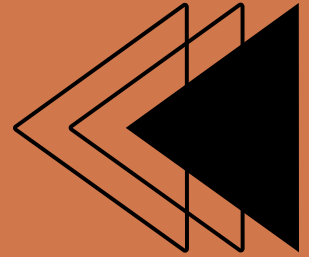
MONTESSORI

- Second graders held creative puppet shows inspired by folk tales from Africa, UK, China & India.

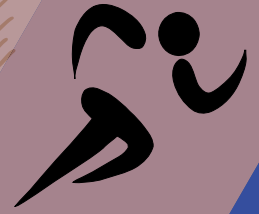
CAMBRIDGE IGCSE, A1 AND A2
