PRE-PRIMARY

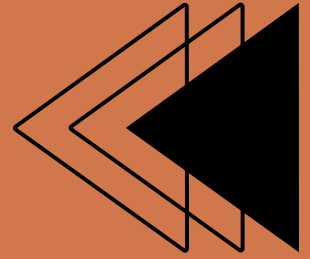

Kruu conducted a workshop for high school students highlighting the importance and advantages of project based learning for a brighter future.

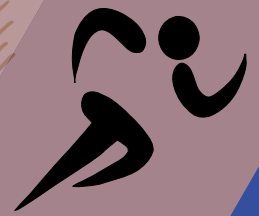
An eye camp was conducted to ensure the wellness of students vision.

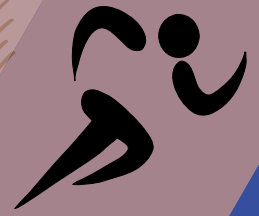

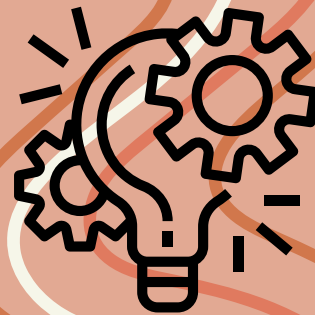
