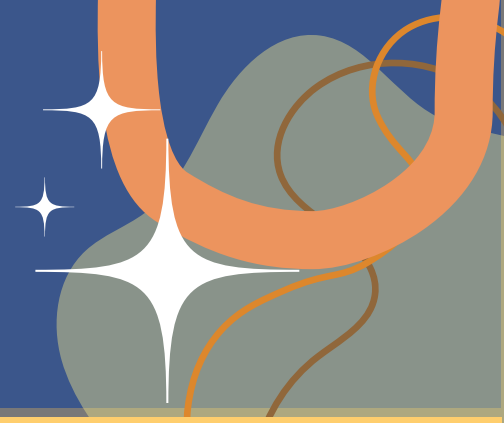

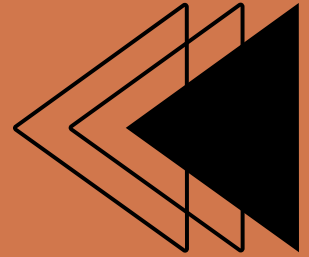
MONTESSORI

- Students sold their artwork at an Art Expo held by the school. The proceeds along with a contribution from the school was put together and donated to the GKNM pediatric cancer center.

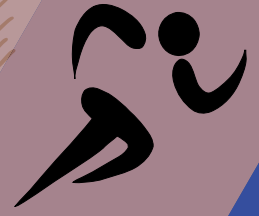
WORKSHOPS FOR GRADES IX & X

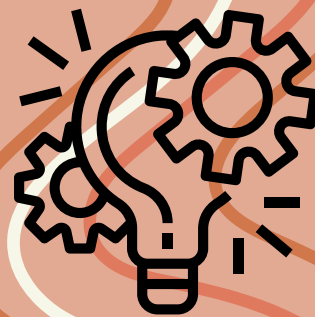

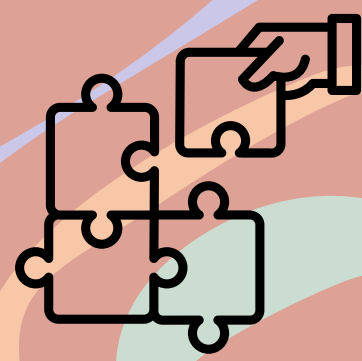
WAGGY WELFARE
